Things to consider from Sunday's message for meditation, conversation and fellowship:

1. If my relationship with my wife was the same today as it was 20 years ago, we wouldn't consider that a good thing. We anticipate relational growth and development.

How does that same principle apply to our relationship with God?

2. If God has fully disclosed Himself so that we might know Him (giving us His Son, His Spirit, His Word), how is it true that we know God about as much as we want to know God?

God knows us completely. We are wide open to Him. How is that comforting to you?

God has opened Himself to us – inviting us into His world, His work, His life! How is that invigorating to you?

3. God's relational cup is not full. He's bringing more & more people into a relationship with Himself.

How are we benefitting from being a part of God's relationship network? How is our relationship with Him growing and developing as a part of the community of God's people?

How are we participating with God in expanding His relational network?

4. According to Hebrews 11:6, God rewards people who pursue Him. He rewards them with Himself.

How rewarding is your relationship with God at the present?

How might that relationship be positively improved?

5. If you were to introduce God to someone, how would you introduce Him?

Our gospel is *the good news of the glory of the happy God*! Our Triune God is beautiful.
