

**Things to consider from Sunday's message for meditation, conversation and fellowship:**

1. Read Isaiah 42:1-9.  
In the context, God is speaking of the character and ministry of His chosen servant (Jesus). Speaking of Jesus, God declares that He shares His glory *with no other*. God shares His glory exclusively with His Son.
  - A. When you think of God's glory, what comes to your mind? What do you know of God's glory from your knowledge of Him revealed in the Scripture (think creation, salvation, consummation)?
  - B. What does Hebrews 1:1-4 teach us concerning the glory of God and the glory of the Son?
  - C. What does Colossians 1:15-20 reveal to us concerning the glory of Jesus?
2. Read John 17:1-5; 20-26.  
The glory God shares exclusively with His Son, His Son shares exclusively with those whom God has given Him (with those who know God through faith in Him and His Son).
  - A. It is the Father's will that the Son share God's glory with those who become one with Him through believing!  
What is your attitude, what are your thoughts, toward God's agenda of sharing His glory with His Son, and then through His Son with those who believe in Him?
  - B. God's love for those who believe in His Son cannot be overstated – He loves them as He loves Jesus!  
How is God's love for you transformative?
3. Read Revelation 4:6-5:14.  
In Revelation 4 and 5 we read about God seated on His throne, and the glory of the resurrected and living Lamb of God (Jesus) who has conquered and purchased people for God from every tribe.
4. Read Revelation 21:9-11.  
In Revelation 21 we see the Bride of Jesus having the glory of God.  
The glory God exclusively shares with His Son, His Son gives away to those who believe in God through Him. In the consummation the Bride of Jesus is glorified and reigns with Jesus forever!
  - A. Those whom God justifies, God glorifies (Rom. 8:26-30).  
God, having given us Jesus, will graciously give us everything. Nothing will separate us from His love (Rom 8:31-39).  
How does the glory this is ours at the consummation of our salvation influence our present experience (Rom. 8:18)?
  - B. Does 1 Peter 1:8-9 describe your attitude toward Jesus?  
How does your relationship with Jesus influence other relationships?

Our gospel is ***the good news of the glory of the happy God!*** Our Triune God is beautiful.
