Larry has also been "ocupado" busy with producing special tools for the field of Papua New Guinea (PNG). After engineering the Propeller stand, he then began building a new instrument panel for the Cessna 206 that we use here in McNeal for training. The mission has determined to upgrade the old panel to a Glass Panel. That involves buying aluminum Sheet metal .100" thick and cutting out the holes for the new G500TXI's and backup instruments. Larry has become the "CNC" machine! This last week, he and 2 other mechanics finished an inspection on our trainer helicopter. And his next task endeavor was to operate heavy equipment for grading the airstrips as the monsoon rains began and in preparation for the new trainee pilots coming next month, he doesn't consider that work.

An item of prayer concern is that our Village Mission's Pastor of our small little church of Valley Bible Church, that Kim and Larry attend and are a part of, has decided to move on to another ministry in California. Since Larry was the last standing deacon on the board, the solemn responsibility has fallen on his shoulders to share the Word of God from the pulpit and rally the men of this body of believers to participate in this commitment. Praise the Lord that other men in the church have stepped up and agreed to contribute for the time being till God provides another Pastor. It is a reminder to all of us who are believers and attend church that God uses all of us and we should not place all the obligation on the Pastor for all the duties of the body of believers.

I, Kim, am doing well and continue to "Flip houses" with my hostess team, as some would word it ③ or preparing housing for the trainees and the guest house as a variety of visitors pass through each year. Larry and I anticipate with joy the arrival of five new families that will be coming here next month, August, to further their training as pilots and mechanics to go to the mission field. Larry will be walking them through rebuilding a helicopter R44 overhaul. The students will eat, drink, live and sleep the Robinson R44 till it is all done!
