A note from Paul:

Thanks for praying for us. Larry, my son, and I just returned from Bolivia, SA. We were asked by the National Organization of Evangelical Churches in Bolivia to come down and share in three churches, commemorating the 75 years that New Tribes Mission has worked in Bolivia beginning with the group of ten adults and six of us children of which I was the youngest, age two.

We arrived there in 1942. My dad Cecil Dye and his brother Bob Dye, my uncle, along with Dave Bacon, Eldon Hunter, and George Hosbach, gave their lives trying to make friendly contact with Ayoreo tribe. The first church we shared in, was in a town approximately 25 miles from the location they were killed at.

While we were down there, we met with pastors and their families from three towns, to encourage them in the ministry which God has given them and ended up speaking in seven more churches in two large cities of Bolivia. God multiplied our opportunities from three scheduled services to eight. Besides, we had the privilege to encourage many other tribal brothers who were involved in translating Scripture in three different tribal languages. Thank you, Lord!!!

The highlight for me was to hear a young Ayoreo pastor who also spoke at one of our meetings. He shared "that because of God's love and the obedience and faithfulness of the five men, those my people 'killed,' God sent others to take their place and share the Gospel of Jesus with my people." Pointing to the audience he said, "now we who believe in Jesus are all family in Christ and have the Holy Spirit of God living in our hearts to teach and guide us all!!"

Please pray for this Ayoreo pastor and his wife! His name is Roly. Many of the Ayoreo youth have moved into the city of Santa Cruz. Pastor Roly says he is teaching them the Word of God. Pray for these youth as "there are many deceitful temptations the enemy is using to destroy them," Pastor Roly told me. Thanks for praying. You are an important part of what God is doing in hearts in Bolivia!!
